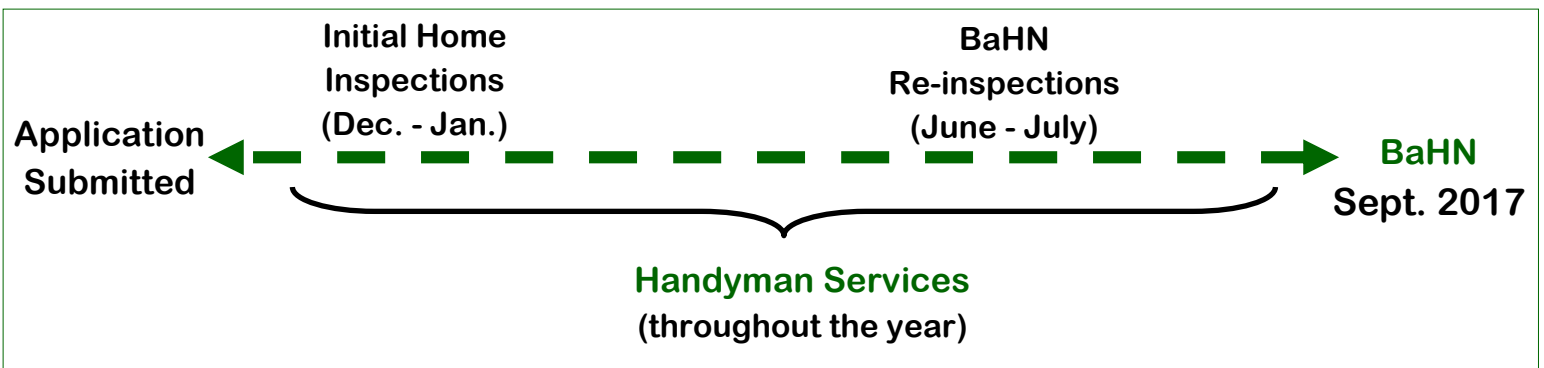
**HANDYMAN PROGRAM**

The Handyman Program is designed to provide home repairs to senior homeowners in the Govans community. This program is for homeowners who are age 60 and older. The program focuses on ensuring that each senior is living in a safe and healthy home. Handyman projects will occur throughout the year. These projects may range from basic home safety modifications such as installing a hand rail or grab bar, but they may also include more involved repairs such as replacing windows or doors.



**BaHN PROGRAM**

Building a Healthy Neighborhood (BaHN) is a partnership between Rebuilding Together and Lowe's. A different city is chosen for BaHN every year. For 2017, Baltimore has been chosen. Up to 500 volunteers will work on projects over a two-day period in September. Volunteers will provide critical home repairs, energy efficiency updates, and health and safety modifications for 10-12 neighborhood homes. Volunteers will also rejuvenate community spaces in the neighborhood. Additionally, there will be a community resource fair as part of the event. Homes that are being considered for BaHN will be reinspected in the summer. BaHN home repair projects will be more extensive than the Handyman projects.
