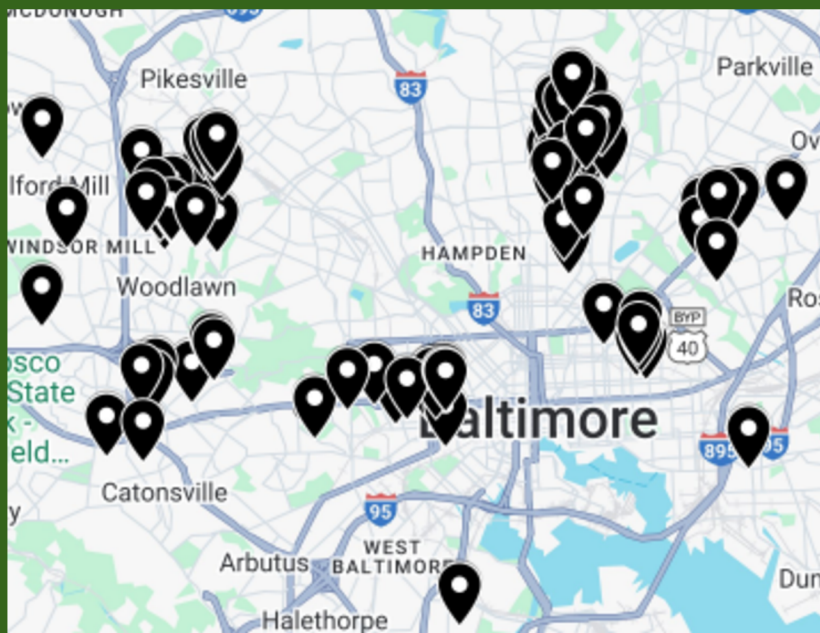

## Homeowner Story: Mr and Mrs. C

Mr. and Mrs C, age 85 and 71, have lived in their Frankford neighborhood in East Baltimore for over 30 years. She and her husband purchased the home from her sister-in-law. Mrs. C grew up in Baltimore and used to visit the area before finally settling there. Speaking about the area, she said, "I love how quiet this neighborhood is, and everyone knows one another. I have neighbors that I've known for years. Neighbors will help me carry groceries into my home and anything else I need help with." Mrs. C is fond of the fact that her home is one story, which makes it easier for her to age in place.

- Replace roof that was leaking and caused a ceiling to collapse
- Clean up and clear out the home
- Complete landscaping and beautification around property
- Lay new flooring in the kitchen
- Repair damaged retaining wall

### Reduction in Stress

81% of homeowners reported a reduction in stress after repairs were completed



### Better Health

65% of homeowners reported improved mental or physical health after repairs



### Reduction In Falls

74% of homeowners who reported falling in their home before repairs reported no falls after repairs.



### Financial Well-being

60% of homeowners reported that their home is more valuable to them and their family after repairs.
